English	 Writing In non-narrative writing we will be looking at explanation texts and writing instructions. We will also focus on the structure of poems and the creation of our own poetry. Spelling Punctuation and Grammar There will continue to be a huge emphasis on this to improve the quality of the children's writing. This half term, we will focus on word classes, descriptive language and homophones. In Spellings, the children will be learning spelling rules when adding a variety of suffixes. They are expected to learn the spelling words that are stuck into their planners every two weeks , in preparation for the spelling test and dictation, during which sentence punctuation, current spelling words and spelling words from previous weeks are tested.						
Maths We will continue to work on simple fractions of amounts and shapes and will also look a methods for solving problems related to number and measurement.							
Science	The children will be working scientifically: observing, asking questions, performing simple tests, offering answers to questions and gathering and recording information. We will continue to investigate plants: growth from seeds and bulbs, seed dispersal and how a plant changes as it matures.						
Computing	Coding lessons will take place on Fridays. The children will also have the opportunity to use ipads to enhance their work in English and Maths.
