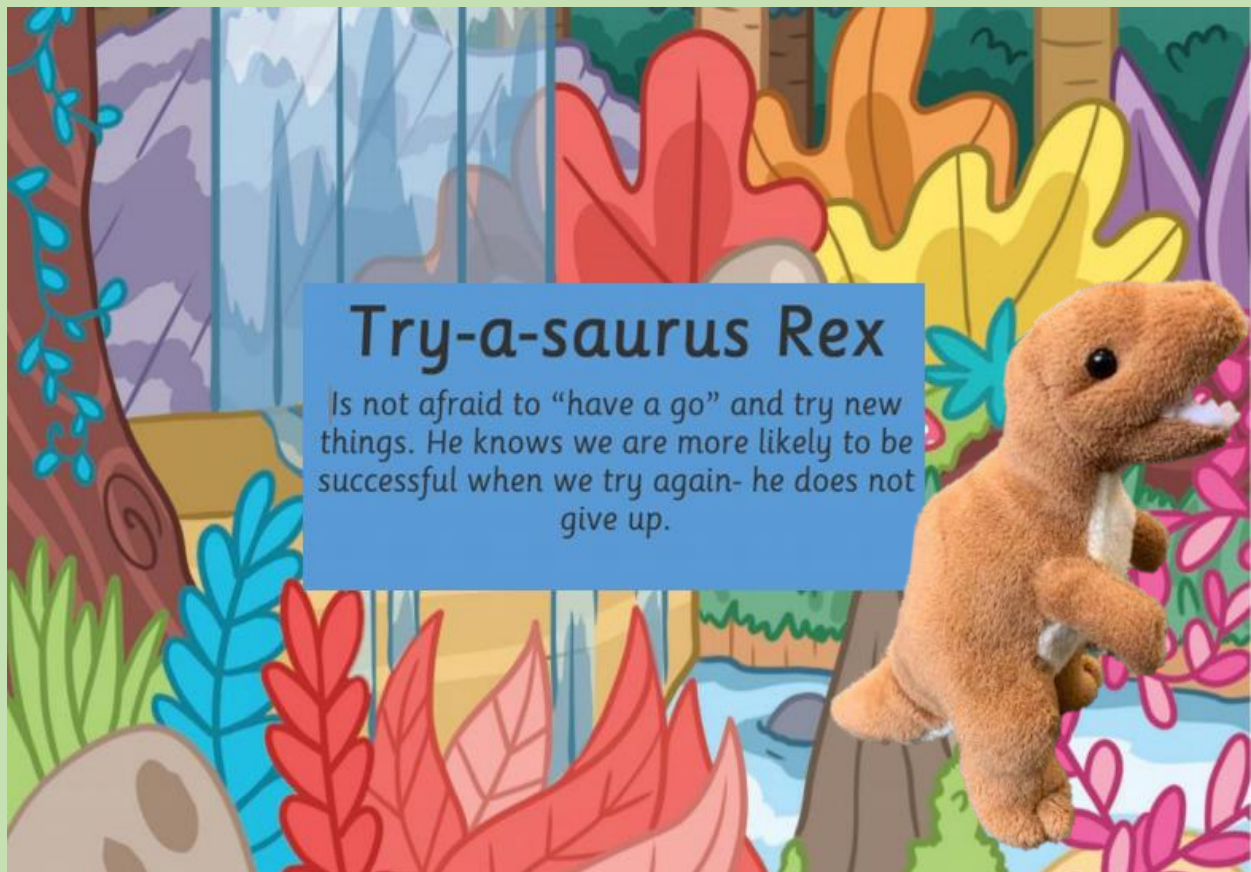
The 'Achieve-o-saurus' Family

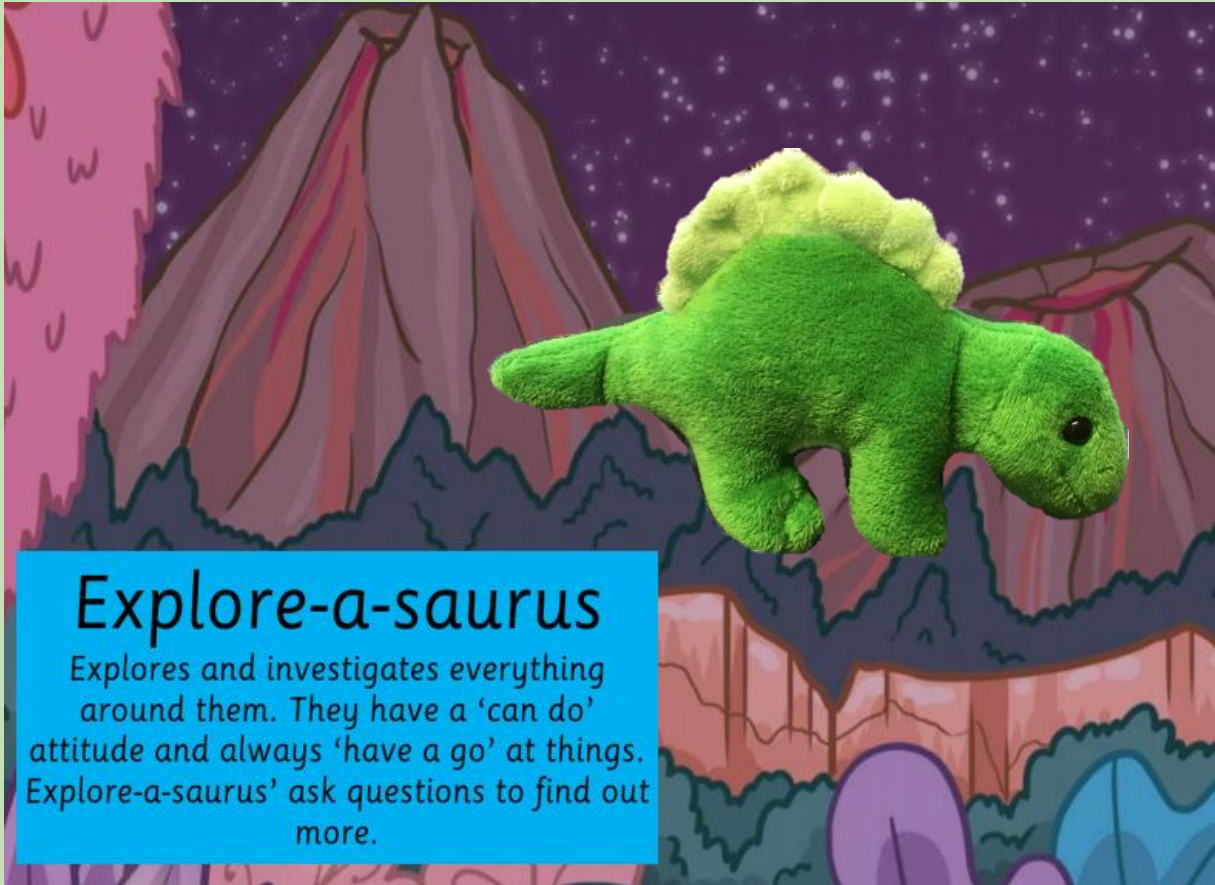
