Return to School Guidelines March 8th 2021 **KEY STAGE 2**

General Guidelines:

- Pupils must wear their school uniform, but they can wear trainers as they will no longer be getting changed for P.E. .Instead, lessons will be done in uniform (remove tie and jumper), wearing trainers. Earrings/extreme hair styles are not allowed and this still must be addressed.
- No school bags/P.E. kits. In Key Stage 2, we will not be using the cloakroom areas to avoid bubbles mixing. Year 3, however, may use their cloakroom as only your year group bubble will be using this space. Year 5 may also use the cloakroom area for coats etc.
- In all other KS 2 classrooms, coats should be put on the back of pupils' chairs.
- All stationery/equipment will be provided for each pupil. Stationery must be named and stored in pupil's individual tray.
- Pupils may bring a named water bottle into school every morning. This cannot be refilled in school (unless it is exceptionally hot weather). Children must take their bottles home every evening to wash and refill.
- Pupils who have a packed lunch may continue to bring in their own packed lunch. These will be stored in the classroom.
- **Homework** - no paper copies will be sent home. Instead, please continue to use Seesaw to set homework and to monitor reading.
- **Planners will not be used at this present time.** Please use Seesaw to communicate with teachers.

Daily Routines

May we respectfully ask that parents do not congregate in groups outside the school gates. Please arrive to drop off/collect your time at the designated time, and no earlier. We would encourage all adults to wear a face mask.

There will be 4 entry/exit sites for KS 2 pupils to minimise contact. These are as follows:

Courtyard Doors - Year 6

Y5 Exit Door/Let's Play Door - Year 5

Main Entrance - Year 4

Y3 Exit Door - Year 3

- SLT (wearing Hi- Viz vests) will supervise pupil entry onto school grounds by directing pupils to their specific entrance .
- T.A.s from each year group will help to direct pupils by their entrance points, wearing Hi-Viz vests.
- Pupils will line up in their classes, socially distancing as much as possible. Teachers will meet their class at the entrance point to take them into school.
