Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Arrangements for Virtual Parents' Evenings - Schoolcloud

As you may know we will be conducting the above evening events using Schoolcloud as our main digital platform for delivering this on Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th October between 3.30pm and 6.30pm. We are conducting mini-trials with some teachers and some parents.

Unless you are contacted by your class teacher via Seesaw to make separate arrangements then you should book your appointment for the 19th OR the 20th October 2021.

Your child's teacher may contact you to make an appointment via Zoom which may even be after half - term, but for the majority of parents and carers your appointment will be for 5 minutes on the 19th OR the 20th October.

As these are professional meetings then we would ask you to respect the process by ensuring that you are able to conduct the discussion in a way conducive to the nature of the proceedings by :

- Ensuring that your camera should be on at all times (so will the teacher's camera).
- Ensuring you have a space where you will not be uninterrupted
- Ensure you are properly attired (not wearing PJs or a bathrobe).
- Try to write down any questions you have in advance of the discussion.

Our teachers reserve the right to bring the discussions to a premature end if they think that the above guidelines are not being adhered to for any reason.

If there are any technical difficulties and your time is cut short, then we will make alternative arrangements to make this up to you.

These appointments are only intended to share with you how your child has settled down into their new class and suggest some ways in which they can work towards improvement.
